These applications along with the proposals are to be directed to the Research and Development Cell of the college. It is expected that all applications comply with the set guidelines and are submitted within the stipulated time frame.
- 2. The Research and Development (R&D) Cell, headed by the Principal as the Chairman, constitutes an Evaluation Committee responsible for selecting proposals.
- 3. The committee recommends the most suitable proposals and submits a report to the R&D Cell for further review.
- 4. Based on the recommendation the R&D Cell sends the offer letter to the selected candidate and asked to apply for financial assistance. The college authority makes partial payment of the total grant of Rs. 40000/-. The payment of the remaining amount is subject to the final submission of the Report.
- 5. The researcher is provided one year for completion of the research project from that of the issue of the offer letter.
- 6. During the allotted period, the researcher:
 - i. Completes literature survey
 - ii. Makes necessary data collection
 - iii. Gives progress report after 6 months
 - iv. Gives pre-submission presentation for final submission of the report.
 - v. Makes final submission of the Report.
