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## ACTION TAKEN REPORT

### ON THE BASIS OF STUDENTS' FEEDBACK ANALYSIS REPORT SUBMITTED BY IQAC FOR THE ACADEMIC SESSION 2022-2023

On the basis of Students' Feedback Analysis Report for the Academic Session 2022-2023 submitted by IQAC of Nalbari Commerce College, Nalbari, the college authority took following actions for bringing changes to the aspects as recommended by the IQAC.

<mark>SI. No.</mark>	Observation/Recommendation by the IQAC	Action taken by the college authority
1	Students demands increase in number of journals and magazines in the Central Library. Hence, number of journals and magazines needs to be increased.	The college authority purchased book as per recommendation of the departments of the college.
2	The reading space in the Central Library should be expanded as the existing space is congested for the current students.	Regarding expansion of reading space, the college authority could not take any action. However, if the classroom adjacent to the library can be shifted to some other building, then it would be used for reading space.
3	Students are not satisfied with the number of journals and newspapers in the Central Library. Number of journals and newspapers needs to be increased	The library committee was entrusted with responsibility to take necessary steps in this regard.
4	Students are not highly satisfied with the Canteen services. More food item needs to be added.	The college authority asked the Canteen Committee to take necessary measures and accordingly some new items were made available in the canteen.
5	A permanent playground for outdoor games needs to be created as the college has no space for outdoor games.	The problem of shortage of a permanent playground could not be solved. However, the college authority decided to continue the agreement with Nalbari College for using their playground as before for holding outdoor games.
